This is also Jackie's fourth year at Spalding after working in the business world for two years. Jackie has taught at the high school level and worked with children at the elementary level. As a Junior Honors level English teacher at Spalding, Jackie has extensive knowledge of the new SAT writing section. Her creative and innovative ideas help keep the curriculum fresh and up to date.



The Program

The program will consist of 10 sessions each designed to increase the students' aptitude, comfort, and knowledge of the new SAT. Each session is capped at 20 students, which ensures individualized instruction and attention.

The first session will be a diagnostic test to ascertain each student's base level score. The students will take an SAT exam from year's past under the exact testing conditions specified by the College Board. Studies have shown that the more times a student takes the actual test, the more comfortable they become with the material and the higher their score will be.

The following seven sessions will individually address student's strengths and weaknesses. Each class will devote time to the math, verbal, grammar, and writing skills students need to utilize on the test. In addition to the skills-based instruction, students will learn the structure of the test the grading system, tricks and tips that can facilitate a higher score.

The ninth session will consist of a final diagnostic exam to ascertain the progress and accomplishments of each student. Lastly, in the final session we will individually meet with each student and outline their continued studies up to their actual testing date.

Details

The course is open to Spalding students between their Sophomore and Senior year. The sessions will be held on the campus of Archbishop Spalding High School in Severn, MD.

Due to our small size, we offer one of the best student to teacher ratios of any prep. session in the area. The small class size ensures individualized attention and instruction at all times.

Students should come to sessions dressed comfortably and bring with them a pen, pencil and a notebook. A short break will be offered during each session and students are welcome to bring a drink and/or a snack with them to class. Vending machines are also available in the school.

Each student will receive as part of the course a textbook, CD, and online testing materials. These comprehensive test materials provide the basis for instruction for the class as well as the materials for the student's continued independent study.

Every student, upon completion of the program, will receive an individualized assessment of his or her progress and a comprehensive evaluation.
